INSPECTION ITEMS

- 1. Check brakes lines & cables
- 2. Inspect brake pads and rotors
- 3. Check automatic transaxle/transmission oil or CVT fluid
- 4. Check tire repair sealant expiration date
- 5. Check transfer fluid & differential gear oil
- 6. Inspect propellar shaft & drive shaft boots
